

AJEA Peer Review Policy

- The **Journal** is a double-blind peer review procedure.
- The **journal** is dedicated to carrying out the research evaluation and arbitration procedure in a timely, professional, and effective manner. Additionally, the journal pledges to keep all information pertaining to the research submitted during the evaluation and arbitration processes completely confidential and to only reveal the research's content to the editorial board, the arbitrators, and the researcher in their respective capacities.
- The editorial board is dedicated to following the conclusions and observations of the reviewers and requiring researchers to make the necessary observations and changes in compliance with the relevant journal requirements. The final choice about whether to accept or reject submitted research, together with the reasons for acceptance or rejection, is also its professional responsibility.
- Following the completion of the peer review process, the referees' recommendations and their own assessment and a decision will determine whether:
 - Acceptance for publication without revision.
 - Revisions are needed for publication.
 - Rejection for Publication.
